- ▶ Cefndir
 - ▶ Cyd-destun deddfwriaethol - Deddf Gwasanaethau Cymdeithasol a Llesiant (Cymru) a Deddf Cenedlaethau'r Dyfodol (Cymru) 2015
 - ▶ 2018 - Comisiynodd GCC waith i archwilio i ddulliau 'cadernid cymunedol' – [Creu cadernid cymunedol](#)
 - ▶ Ymgysylltiad adnabyddus gyda phartïon â diddordeb, ac awydd i ymchwilio ymhellach
 - ▶ Cadernid → Dyfeisgarwch
 - ▶ Ehangodd y grŵp ffocws cychwynnol yn ystod COVID
- ▶ Fforwm traws-sector unigryw yn hyrwyddo ymarfer da wrth ddarparu gwasanaethau cyhoeddus yn y gymuned
- ▶ Rôl allweddol wrth bontio polisi ac arfer
- ▶ Cynhelir gan Gofal Cymdeithasol Cymru
- ▶ Aelodaeth – 80 o aelodau ar draws VCS, llywodraeth leol, y byd academaidd, cyrff cenedlaethol

The Partnership

- ▶ Background
 - ▶ Legislative context - Social Services & Wellbeing (Wales) Act and Future Generations (Wales) Act 2015
 - ▶ 2018 – SCW commissioned work to explore approaches to 'community resilience' - [Approaches to community resilience](#)
 - ▶ Engagement identified interested parties and a desire to explore further
 - ▶ Resilience → Resourcefulness
 - ▶ The group expanded significantly during COVID
- ▶ A unique cross-sectoral forum promoting good practice in community based delivery of public services
- ▶ Key role in bridging policy and practice
- ▶ Hosted by Social Care Wales
- ▶ Membership – 80 members from across VCS, local government, academia, national bodies

Amcanion

- ▶ Dod â diddordeb, ymchwil a phrofiad o ymarfer at ei gilydd i **gyflymu arferion da** mewn gweithredu/gweithgareddau cymunedol sy'n hyrwyddo lles cymunedol, dyfeisgarwch ac adeiladu pŵer cymunedol
- ▶ Defnyddio gwybodaeth ac ymarfer aelodau i **ddylanwadu ar bolisiâu a phenderfyniadau** ar lefel leol, rhanbarthol a chenedlaethol, gan feithrin gallu a sgiliau mewn cymunedau i gynyddu a gwella eu dyfeisgarwch
- ▶ **Hyrwyddo a rhoi gwybod am y sylfaen dystiolaeth a'r ymchwil** ar gyfer gweithredu/gweithgareddau sy'n cefnogi gweithredu a arweinir gan y gymuned.

Objectives

- ▶ Bring together interest, research and practice experience to **accelerate good practice** in community action/activities that promote community wellbeing, resourcefulness and build community power
- ▶ Use the knowledge and practice of members to **influence policy and decision-making** at local, regional and national levels, building capacity and skills within communities to increase and enhance their resourcefulness
- ▶ To **inform and promote the evidence base and research** for action/activities that support community led action and power

- ▶ Grŵp llywodraethu traws-sectoraidd gan gynnwys CLILC, CGGC, GCC gyda chyd-gadeiryddion sy'n cynrychioli'r sectorau cymunedol a chyhoeddus
- ▶ Wedi sefydlu adroddiad arfer da ac egwyddorion ar gyfer meithrin cadernid cymunedol
- ▶ [Adroddiad ar Ddyfeisgarwch Cymunedol – Fframwaith ar gyfer Gweithredu](#) → 2 x cynllun peilot yng Ngorllewin a Gogledd Cymru i brofi'r fframwaith – Fframwaith rhyngweithiol diwygiedig
- ▶ Cyfres o gyfarfodydd gyda nifer o randdeiliad dros dair blynedd sydd wedi archwilio arferion da a meysydd polisi sy'n dod i'r amlwg

 - ▶ Ion/Chwefror 2022 & Mawrth 2023
 - ▶ 190+ yn bresennol o 150 o sefydliadau

Achievements to date

- ▶ Cross sectoral governance group including WLGA, WCVA, SCW with co-chairs representing the community and public sectors
- ▶ Good practice report and principles for building community resilience established
- ▶ [Community Resourcefulness Report – A Framework for Action](#) → 2 x pilots in West and North Wales to test the framework → Revised interactive framework
- ▶ Series of multi-stakeholder meetings over three years that have explored good practice and emerging policy areas
- ▶ [Shared learning events](#)
 - ▶ Jan/Feb 2022 & March 2023
 - ▶ 190+ attendees from 150 organisations
- ▶ Initial engagement with WG regarding [Communities Policy](#)

Future work programme

- ▶ Adeiladu a hyrwyddo'r Bartneriaeth
- ▶ Adolygu aelodaeth a sicrhau bod llais cymunedau yn ganolog i'n gwaith
- ▶ Mae dysgu a rhwydweithio yn cynorthwyo staff y sector cyhoeddus a chymunedau i:
 - ▶ weithio'n fwy effeithiol gyda'i gilydd,
 - ▶ Mynd i'r afael â heriau a rennir
 - ▶ datblygu sgiliau a dealltwriaeth well o alluogwyr allweddol gweithio effeithiol
- ▶ Ehangu cwmpas y gwaith y tu hwnt i ofal cymdeithasol i feysydd eraill lle mae gan ymarfer cydgynhyrchiol botensial sylweddol

- ▶ Build and promote the Partnership
- ▶ Review membership and ensure the voice of communities is central to our work
- ▶ Learning and networking aiding public sector staff and communities to:
 - ▶ Work more effectively together
 - ▶ Address shared challenges
 - ▶ Develop better skills and understanding of key enablers of effective working
- ▶ Expand scope of work beyond social care into other areas where co-productive practice has significant potential

Future work programme

- ▶ Adolygu a chyfuno'r dystiolaeth o'r gwersi a ddysgywyd o'r pandemig ynghylch yr hyn sy'n gweithio i gefnogi a chyfoethogi gweithredu cymunedol - er mwyn gwella canlyniadau llesiant i unigolion a chymunedau
 - ▶ Wedi'i arwain gan Ganolfan Polisi Cyhoeddus Cymru
 - ▶ Yn deillio o sgyrsiau o fewn Coleg Brenhinol y Meddygon a gyda rhwydweithiau eraill ledled Cymru a thu hwnt
 - ▶ Canolbwytio ar y berthynas rhwng partneriaid mewn gweithredu cymunedol a ffyrdd cydweithredol o weithio.
 - ▶ Adnabod ac ymateb i amrywiol hanesion, cyddestunau a phrofiadau o weithredu cymunedol.
 - ▶ Bydd yn defnyddio dull cydweithredol i gynnal ymchwil dylunio
- ▶ Evidence review and synthesis of lessons learnt from the pandemic on what works to support and enhance community action to improve wellbeing outcomes for individuals and communities
 - ▶ Led by the Wales Centre for Public Policy
 - ▶ Emerges from conversations within the RCP and with other networks across Wales and beyond.
 - ▶ Focus on relationships between partners in community action and collaborative ways of working.
 - ▶ Recognise and respond to diverse histories, contexts and experiences of community action.
 - ▶ Will take a collaborative approach to research design.

About the framework

- ▶ For people who want to understand and work with communities to develop ideas, partnerships and projects
- ▶ To be used by public bodies including councils, health boards and support organisations who want to work with communities
- ▶ Created by Social Care Wales and the Resourceful Communities Partnership
- ▶ Informed by an action research project and tested in two Welsh communities – has been shaped by what communities think and what we know works
- ▶ Focuses on principles, ingredients for success and key areas of focus
